Our multi-user online subscribers will continue to access the publication as usual on a newly redesigned website, which includes a searchable archive. For those subscribers who currently subscribe to both the print and PDF versions, their subscriptions will be extended by two additional issues.

We know that this change involves an adjustment on your part, but we are sure that you will quickly adjust to the new delivery method. Because the PDF format is identical to the print edition, you may still print the file locally and read the publication as usual. And there are additional benefits to you, including:

- Fast Delivery. No delays for printing and mailing.
- No waiting for the print issue to be routed within your organization.
- PDF files will include “live” links to source documents, including audio and video files.
- Back-issue archive. As a subscriber, you may access the full-text archive of past issues online at [www.foodprotectionreport.com](http://www.foodprotectionreport.com).

This change will enable us to avoid subscription increases because of higher print and packaging or shipping costs and will allow us to channel more resources into *FPR*'s content.
